Under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1925 the District Council is the relevant authority with regard to naming of streets, and I should therefore be pleased to receive any observations which your parish council may wish to make in respect of the proposed name. Any observations should be submitted as soon as possible, but in any event no later than the **25<sup>th</sup> of December 2024**. If I have not heard from you by that time, I shall assume that your parish council has no objection to the proposal.

Any objection put forward by you, if appropriate, will be considered and if necessary will be taken to the Portfolio Holder who will then decide, if agreement cannot be reached with the developer, whether to submit a formal objection with the Courts under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1925. Examples of objections, which would be considered as valid would be:

- that the proposed name was already in use or earmarked elsewhere;
- that the proposed name was inappropriate for a particular locality;
- that confusion might arise because of a similar name already existing;
- or that the name was ridiculous or distasteful etc.

It is unlikely that a court would uphold any objection to a developer's proposed name simply on the grounds that the Council prefers an alternative name, and you are therefore respectfully requested to bear these points in mind when responding.



- c) To resolve to agree a response to Park Road, Holbeach waiting restrictions proposal.

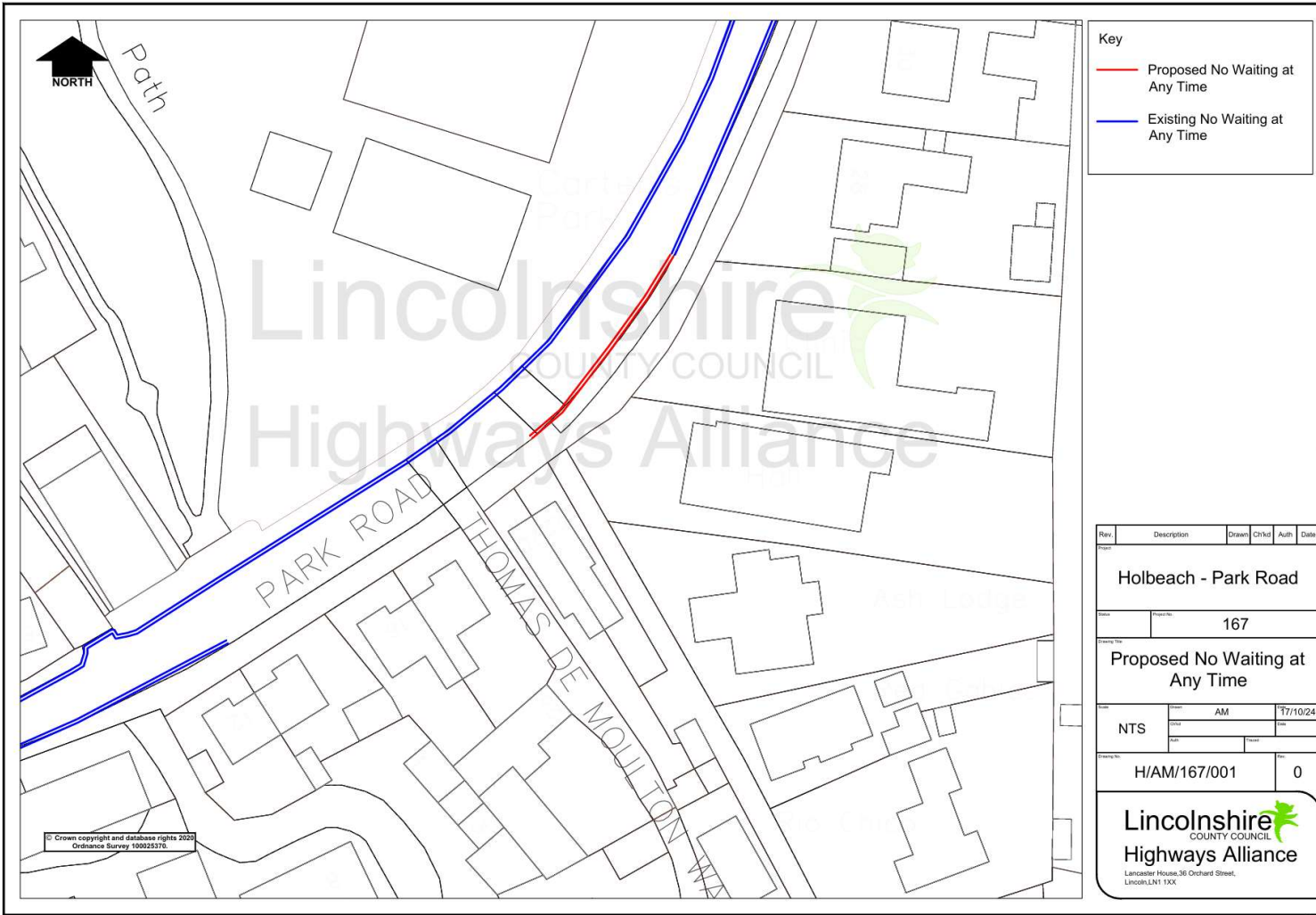
**RE: HOLBEACH, PARK ROAD – PROPOSED NO WAITING AT ANY TIME RESTRICTION**

Lincolnshire County Council recently received a request to review the waiting restrictions at the above location.

Investigations have shown that inconsiderate and dangerous parking close to accesses are impeding access and egress causing poor visibility and safety concerns for all road users.

To maintain traffic flow, improve visibility and highway safety in this area it is proposed to introduce a no waiting at any time restriction.

The details of this scheme are shown on the attached plan and I look forward to receiving any comments you may wish to make. If I do not receive a response by **13<sup>th</sup> January 2025**, I will assume that you have no objections to the proposal.

**PPES - 2024/5-081 - Properties**

As you know the Memorial was privately sponsored and donated in 1921 and given to the people of the town by John Hardy Carter.

In 1938 the Royal British Legion stood the expense of creating the entrance through the Church Wall from the High Street.

In 1949 more restoration was again paid for by the Royal British Legion.

In 1947 an article put before the parochial church council stated that articles presented to the Church such as war memorials could be purchased without tax if so required?

1978 (Lincs Free Press) : the Holbeach British Legion approached the Parish Council asking for help towards the maintenance of the War Memorial. The Council basically questioned the request seemingly on the grounds that it was in the Church Yard which is not Council property and not their responsibility. The Legion went on to quote extracts from the War Memorials Act of 1923 which I am sure you have probably read but basically states: " A local authority may incur reasonable expenditure in the maintenance, repair and protection of any war memorial within their district whether vested in them or not". There were then subsequent amendments of wording in government acts of 1948.

In December 1993 the Parish Council appealed in the Lincs Free Press for a volunteer to clean the War Memorial.

In November 1996 Jill Harrington of the Parish Council appealed in the Spalding Guardian for sponsorship from individuals or businesses to erect new railings around the War Memorial.

\* I actually made and erected the railings myself a few months later, which still exist today. To be honest I do not know if we sponsored the railings or who (if anyone) paid for them?

The Imperial War Museum keep records of War Memorials and certain associated paperwork, but not sure if it will help?
