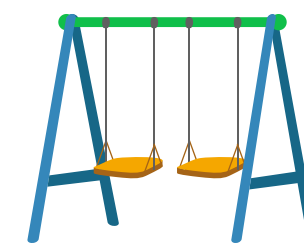
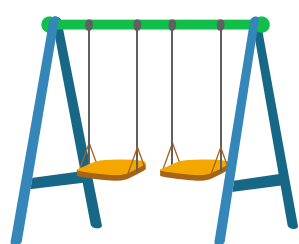

## Holbeach Parish Council Expands Grass Cutting Operations with New Equipment Investment

Holbeach Parish Council has taken significant steps to enhance its grass maintenance services by bringing previously outsourced cutting areas into its remit. The affected locations—Holbeach St Marks, Holbeach Hurn, Holbeach St Johns, and Holbeach Bank, Netherfields and Hallgate — will now be maintained directly by the council's dedicated Park Team. To facilitate this transition, the council has invested in a new truck, enabling the transportation of essential equipment, including Kubota mowers, to various sites efficiently. This decision comes in anticipation of potential local government reorganisation, which may see an increase in green spaces requiring maintenance within the parish. By proactively strengthening its team and upgrading equipment, the council aims to be fully prepared for any additional workload. While this transition took place, some areas experienced temporary delays in grass cutting. The council apologises for any inconvenience caused and appreciates the community's patience during this period. The Park Team has now visited all affected areas, and regular maintenance has resumed. Holbeach Parish Council remains committed to ensuring well-maintained green spaces for residents and looks forward to continuing its efforts to keep parish areas tidy and welcoming.
