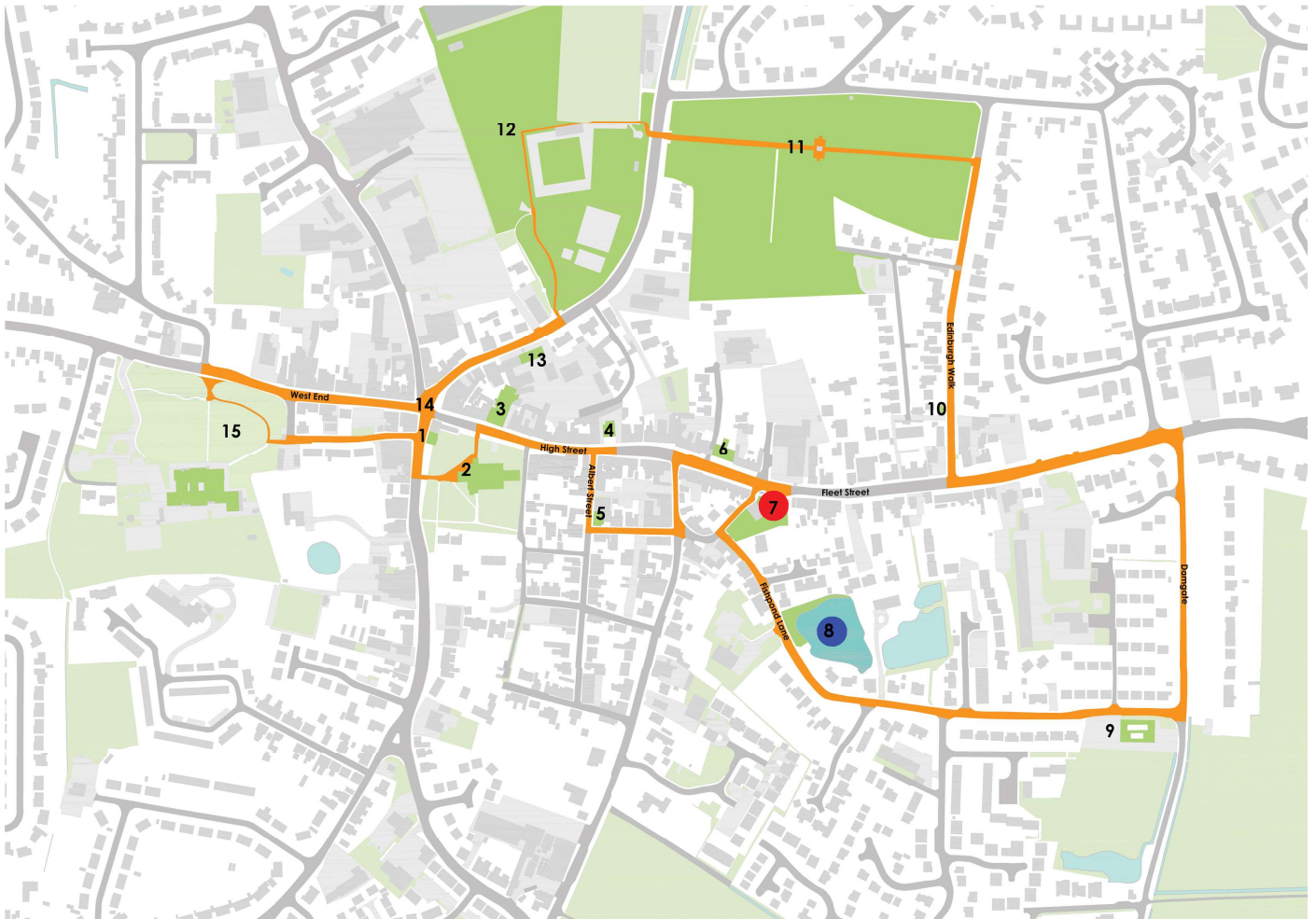
Looking across the road to where the Co-op is now was once the cinema. The Hippodrome opened in 1929 and for many years was the main hub of entertainment for the town. There were matinees on Wednesdays and Saturdays but no showings on a Sunday. Unfortunately, in 1970 the cinema closed.



Standing alongside this was a large house which belonged to Doctor Hunter. He was a well-respected Doctor who practiced for many years in the town. He was chauffeur driven on his rounds in an immaculate Ford V8 Pilot. When he retired the house became a combination of flats and an antique shop until it was bulldozed in the 1970s.
